

Kitchen Spring Cleaning Check List



Spring cleaning your kitchen is best done in 2 parts; focusing on both the inside, and the exterior of your kitchen, ensures a thorough spring clean.

STAGE ONE

- Reduce.** Start with the top cupboards and work your way down, sorting through the contents into keep, donate, repair and toss out piles.
- Repair:** Tighten handles, shelves, knobs and other hardware.
- Disinfect.** Wipe down and disinfect the cupboard shelves with Granite Gold Disinfecting Wipes.
- Wash.** Wash or polish any pots, pans, dishes or platters that you are keeping.
- Organize.** Reline your shelves, and restock with the “keep” contents.
- Detail:** Deep clean the inside of your fridge/freezer. Dishwasher, oven and other appliances.

STAGE TWO

- Dust.** From the top down, dust the ceiling, molding boards and doors.
- Wash.** Windows, screens, hoods and vents.
- Seal & Polish.** Thoroughly clean, seal and polish your natural stone surfaces with the Granite Gold 3 Part System.
- Shine.** Polish and shine the sink, tap and hardware around the sink.
- Detail.** Deep clean your stove top, including the knobs.
